The attached job description outlines the context, purpose and requirements of a vacancy in SURF's Rothesay focused Alliance for Action initiative.

As indicated, SURF intends to recruit a part time, Rothesay Alliance for Action Facilitator. She/he will enable SURF to consolidate and build further on a range of cross sector community regeneration contacts, assets and priorities. These have been identified and linked via a feasibility study phase, which SURF carried out in cooperation with a group of local and institutional stakeholders. That collaborative process has produced a practical shared vision, aimed at supporting the sustainable regeneration of Rothesay.

To take the Alliance and the initial project delivery phase forward effectively, SURF's preference is to recruit a locally based person to this post but it is also willing to consider engaging a suitably experienced consultant on agreeable terms to the same end.

Potential candidates for this post should submit a CV and a covering letter, of no more than 2 pages in each case, indicating experience, skills and qualities relevant to the requirements set out in the person specification.
