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Primary Academic Support

We provide sessions of structured academic study after school. AS raises attainment, encourages young people to become active, independent learners, and helps them to develop study skills.

The tailored **Into**University curriculum is themed by degree subject. Some examples of recent curriculum subjects are Classics, Coding and Astronomy. Each 'degree' covers key Curriculum for Excellence Maths and English experiences and outcomes.

Students are supported by IntoUniversity staff and trained tutors who help them complete their work to a high standard.



Primary FOCUS

The Primary FOCUS programme is a package of focused learning for classes in P3-P7. It is a free programme of immersive educational activities which support students' aspirations and attainment and develop key academic skills and soft skills that promote success at school and beyond.

P6 students participate in a FOCUS week; five days of concentrated learning on a topic chosen by the school. Students go on an off-site trip and visit our partner university to celebrate their hard work in a 'formal' graduation.



IntoUniversity iu Programmes

Mentoring & Enrichment

Students aged 10-17 attending Academic Support have the opportunity to join our Mentoring Programme. They are paired with a university student who provides help with school work, social skills, and confidence-building. The mentors act as role models who have already made it to university, and encourage the young people to think about their futures and raise their aspirations.

We provide a range of bespoke one-off opportunities, from work experiences to paid internships to overseas challenges to university summer schools. Most opportunities are only available through **Into**University and some lead to contextual university offers or paid employment. This programme provides students with access to top quality and impactful extra-curricular and networking opportunities which stand out on their CV/UCAS form.

Secondary Academic Support

Secondary Academic Support involves weekly sessions of focused academic study after school. Students are supported with their homework, coursework and examination revision or work on structured academic enhancing activities such as Independent Learning Projects.

Students will also have the opportunity to apply for our mentoring and work experience programmes.

Students are able to bring their CVs, college applications, UCAS applications and questions about future options to us during AS.



Secondary FOCUS

These workshops provide a cohort of 30 students in each year group with a minimum of 2 workshops a year relevant to the different stages of their school journey.

Each workshop develops skills and knowledge which support students to fulfil their educational and career ambitions.

Workshops are normally 2 hours and take place during the school day. The scheduling of workshops is arranged individually between the schools and ourselves.
