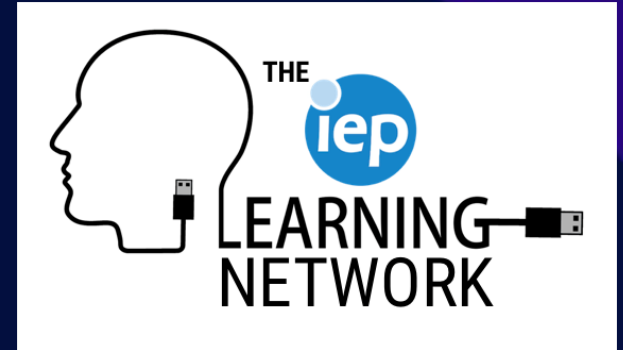


# The IEP Weekly e-Bulletin

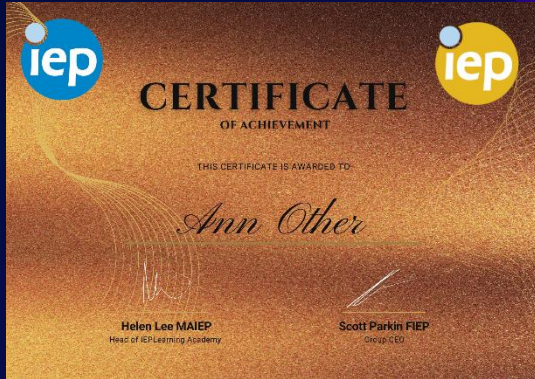
