

Open Funding

- Supports individuals and organisations.
- Supports activity from individual professional development and creating new work to festivals, creative programmes and residencies.
- No deadlines
- Individuals: £500-£100,000 for up to 24 months
- Organisations: £1,000-£100,000 for up to 18 months

Funding Pointers

- Is it the right funder/funding programme.
- One of the other National Lottery distributors may be more appropriate: National Lottery Heritage Fund or National Lottery Community Fund.
- Your project may fit one of Creative Scotland's Targeted or Devolved funds better.
- Read the guidance.
- Make sure your budget adds up.
- Speak to the Enquiries team.
- Remember: there is huge demand on funds, and only around a third of applications can be supported.
