King's and Lord Treasurer's Remembrancer

How does OPTS fit into the KLTR Processes?



KLTR establishes the property is ownerless KLTR advertises the BV property to public bodies and relevant local authorities **OPTS applicant makes an application** Assessment of application by the OPTS Team If successful the OPTS team writes to the team and conveys the property to the applicant






